At least 64 people from Cellardyke died in active service during the First World War. We are going to commemorate them by walking through the village from their homes to the Cellardyke and Kilrenny War Memorial.

The pupils of the Waid Academy and other volunteers are going to represent those who were lost.

There will be a ceremony at the War Memorial including Scottish WW1 poetry reading and WW1 song, and the naming of the dead at 3pm.
