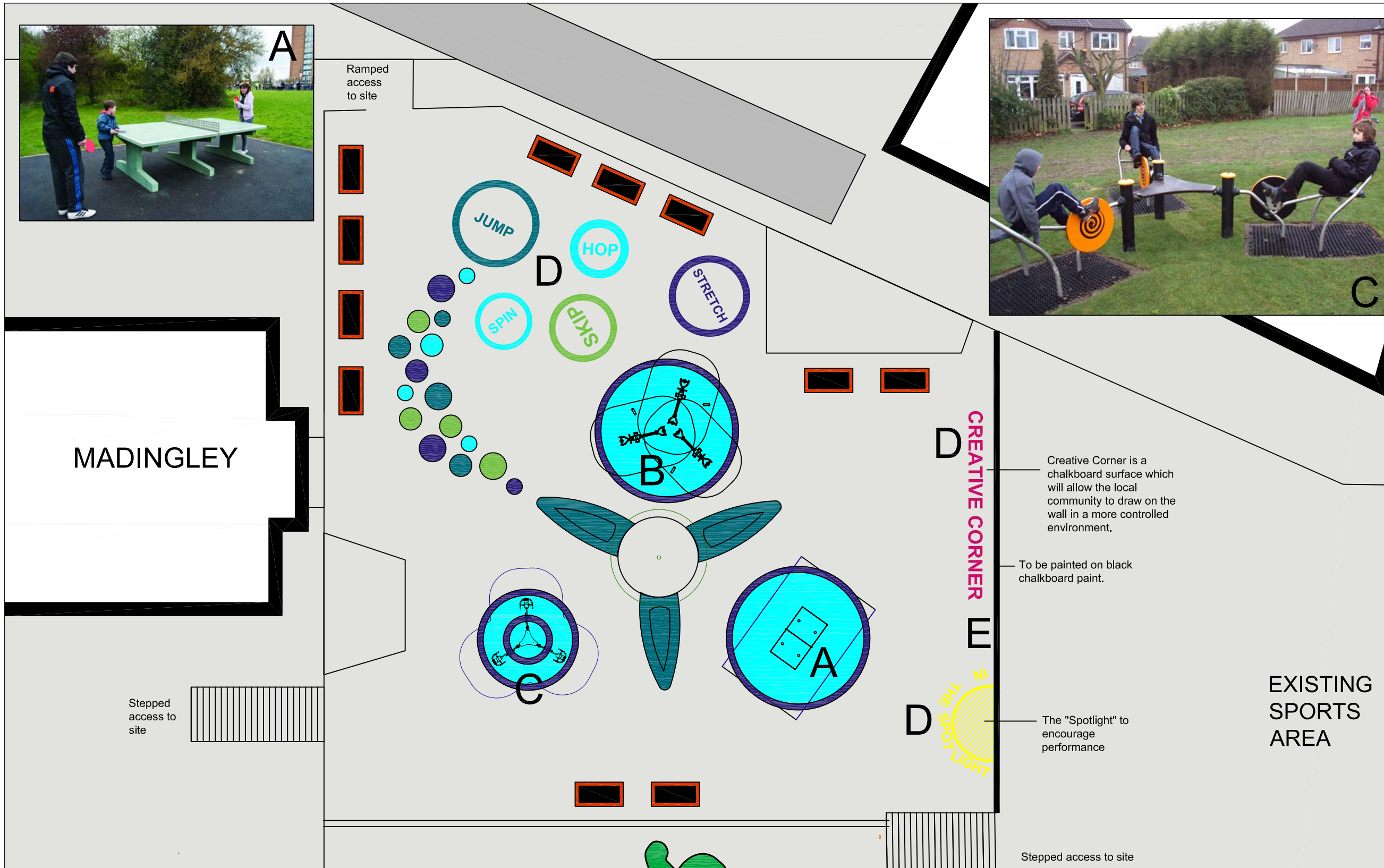
Groundworks
Circles to be painted underneath Table Tennis Table as shown. Circles to extend existing painted circle blocks as shown. Circle blocks not already painted to be painted in colours as shown to match existing. We have also proposed to paint the central seating area to match - although this will ultimately be up to the local community as they have just repainted it. Approximately 140m² tarmac paint required for the above.

99x 2.4m Timber Sleepers made into 3 layer planters (1.4m x 2.4m, 600mm high) bolted together and to the ground. 55m² soil required to fill planters. 20m² sensory planting and shrubs required.

Removal of 4x Concrete Posts, Tyre Planters, Unused Concrete and any other debris.

Design based on having a full structural survey of the roof area.

Exact layout to be confirmed at pe-start meeting.



Creative Corner is a chalkboard surface which will allow the local community to draw on the wall in a more controlled environment.

To be painted on black chalkboard paint.
