What can you expect from a course?

Tutors will provide a welcoming learning environment which is friendly and accessible.

The training course will follow Lesson Plans and curriculum guidance from the relevant training body for which the tutor will be qualified to deliver.

The tutor will provide a clear outline of the course together with relevant details of the course in the form of an outline of what will be covered by the training. Handouts will be given out and any group work covered during sessions will be gone through to ensure understanding.

For courses over a number of weeks, flip charts and overheads can be word processed and circulated the following week.

The tutor will keep to the timings for sessions as advertised.

To contribute to discussions and group work as appropriate

Please treat all staff and other learners with politeness, fairness and respect

If you are unable to attend a session for any reason, that you make every effort to contact the tutor

If you require further time for any work to be submitted, that you speak to the tutor in plenty of time before the deadline to arrange extensions.

To give feedback at the end of a course by completing an evaluation form or giving verbal feedback to the tutor

If you need to leave before the course finishes, that you inform the tutor of the reason why.

We aim to provide access to learning opportunities for all.

We can offer support for those wishing to undertake a training course. Most training courses offered are relatively practical.

Where written work is required, tutors are able to offer one to one support and additional time to ensure all students feel able to succeed.
