Children are able to freely leave the session at any time. Where you do not wish this to happen, please explain this to your child and inform the staff. Parents should complete a Registration and Consent form before leaving their child at a session. This will provide a contact telephone number for you should we need to speak to you or contact you in an emergency.
