- Working collaboratively where possible and
- Challenging effectively when these aims are not met

The network is open to all groups based or operating in B&NES regardless of size. We aim to support the sharing of knowledge, information and skills so that the sector can develop its' capabilities and peers can support each other. As the needs of children and young people are at the centre of our work, we are also committed to true participation at all levels.
