





Housing Options and Homeless Team

- » We offer a quality housing advice service accessible to the public and service providers both internal and external to reduce homelessness with early intervention and gaining positive outcomes through prevention work.
- » Drop in daily at One Stop Shop
- » Telephone advice daily
- » Outreach service Keynsham/MSN
- » Hospital MH Weekly
- » LD service
- » Home visits
- » All officers have a duty when other issues are identified i.e. money matters to refer to all appropriate services
- » We would ask that all services contact us as early as possible to ensure early intervention to prevent homelessness, we have a very accessible service, an officer is always available in person, telephone, visits, safeguarding and other professional meetings.

Homesearch

- You can apply if you have a low income and a local connection. Over 6000 households are registered and grouped in bands depending on their priority and housing need. 176 (average) new applications are received every month.
- » 650 properties were let during the year 2014-2015.
