## Terms of Reference Common Assessment Audit Meetings

## Purpose of the group

The purpose of this group is to:

- Audit a selection of common assessments across the 0-19 age range, including those completed on unborn babies
- Ensure formal communication on quality matters between a multiagency audit group and the children's and adult workforce Report on the quality of common assessments and the resulting integrated packages of support (where available)
- Strengthen accountability and partnership arrangements for the use of common assessment as integral to early help
- Inform future implementation of integrated processes and associated training

## Relationship to other groups/Governance

This group aims to complement the quality assurance function of the Professional Practice Sub-Committee (LSCB) but at the level of audit of universal 'early help' assessments.
