## Childrens Trust Board Meeting $10^{\text {th }}$ December 2015

- Future governance will be changing between the CTB, LSCB and the Health \& Wellbeing Board (HWB). The CTB will be disbanded by September 2016 and the HWB will develop a sub-group primarily focused on the current CYPP 2014-17. The sub-group will still require VS representation.
- The CYPN Annual Report was well received and positively commented on. The recommendations that all communication to the Network from B\&NES officers be improved in order to facilitate improved dissemination in adequate timescales, were agreed.
- We raised the need for e-safety training/resources to be made available for parents/carers as this has been highlighted as an area of concern to VS groups working with families which is backed up by the SHEU survey where $48 \%$ of secondary age children get e-safety information from parents. Yet parents are saying they feel out of their depth. LSCB Chair agreed to look into this area
- Child Health Profile for B\&NES showed a rise in the number of children 0-14 years admitted to hospital with injuries ( $40 \%$ from falls) and admissions for self-harm in children aged $10-24$ were also raised. These will be areas to focus preventative work in
- Early Help Strategy was discussed and the need for a standardised framework for reporting outcomes and improved information and intelligence sharing across all sectors was emphasised.
