Survey Objectives

- To find out:
 - How North Sheen Recreation Ground (NSRG) is used
 - What people like or dislike about NSRG
 - What are the benefits of NSRG
 - What new facilities people would like to see in NSRG
 - Any concerns people have about NSRG
 - Opinion on whether NSRG should be locked at night
 - Opinion on whether NSRG should have a Park Keeper
- To invite more people to get involved in Friends of NRSG

Survey Methodology

- Self-completion paper questionnaire
- Distributed via:
 - House to house deliveries by volunteers in the streets around NSRG
 - The NSRG Café
- Collected via sealed boxes in the Café, Kew Library and an address in High Park Road between 10th August and 7th September 2013
- Available for all aged 16+
- 97 replies
- Research advice and analysis by Sue Burden MMRS (free of charge)



Enjoy the café and great playgrounds


Convenient play area for small children. Lots of open space

Spontaneous dislikes: dog mess, anti-social behaviour, too many / threatening dogs, too much football, no park keeper; issues with café / play equipment

Dislikes

Some of the dogs are aggressive and we have seen dog fights. Also the gates are left open [to playgrounds] ..this has meant dogs getting into the playground – one was very aggressive Little obvious park management, which some elements might try to exploit. Bring back water fountain and flower beds.

Too many people come with loud dogs. They seem dangerous. Sometimes I feel scared but can't tell them anything about the dogs.

Dog poo all over the place and dogs running free barking or getting into dog fights The park is a great local asset and I do not dislike anything aside from dog owners not cleaning up after their dogs sometimes The increased antisocial behaviour

The fact there is no full time keeper that can deal with any trouble

The recent decline due to no more park attendants

Dog mess. Large adolescents dominating the play area

Not keen on how the football has overtaken it on Saturdays




It's a lovely place for gathering. Keeps people together and active. Helps to go for running, playing or just having a relaxing walk (health)

A place for all members of the community to enjoy and exercise, especially young people, but not so good for the elderly and disabled







An equal split in perceived improvement and decline at North Sheen Rec






