SOUTH LOCH NESS TRAIL ROUTE

 The South Loch Ness Trail runs along the south and east side of Loch Ness, starting at Torbreck (about 4 miles south of Inverness) and finishing at Loch Tarff (about 4 miles north east of Fort Augustus)

SOUTH LOCH NESS TRAIL DESCRIPTION

- Day 1. Torbreck to Dorres: about 6 miles (easy to moderate). Finish at Dorres Inn (pub lunch)
- Day 2. Dorres to Foyers: about 13 miles (strenuous). Picnic lunch
- Day 3. Foyers to Loch Tarff: Falls of Foyers to Whitebridge : about 3 miles easy (pub lunch).
 Whitebridge to Loch Tarff: about 5 miles (moderate to strenuous)




