The reason for this direction is that there is insufficient information presently available to the Secretary of State to determine whether the proposed development would generate traffic on the Motorway to an extent which would be incompatible with the use of the Motorway as part of the national system of routes for through traffic in accordance with section 10(2) of the Highways Act 1980, and with the safety of traffic on the Motorway.
