1. Chairman's Welcome

Cllr Stratton welcomed everyone.

2. Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on March 2nd 2022

Minutes agreed and signed by Cllr Stratton as a correct record.

3. Rural Engagement Team

Three Police Officers attended to outline the Team's role n addition to their "normal" policing duties.

The main point to come out of the presentation was that a rural crime in progress was a 999. Members of the public were asked to report incidents to the police in the first instance before taking to Social Media. Police resources are calculated on reported crimes. It was important that all incidents are reported even after the event.
