## a) Asheldham Village Notice Board and fallen ECC Yard Fence Panel

The Asheldham Parish Notice Board has been renovated

The planter at the base of the Village Sign has been treated with wood preserve and the sign cleaned. The original planter on the land opposite Sandlings has also been treated with wood preserve.

The grass verge bordering the pony field adjacent to Sandlings is in the course of being trimmed to make visibility of oncoming motorists better on the corner. Brambles and grass have been cut back in an effort to make the whole of the verge less of an eyesore.

The facia of the hedge belonging to the animal sanctuary (Tower Hill Stables) has been trimmed as much as possible but a specialist tall ladder is required or some other means of cutting back the higher parts. Also, the hedge between the triangle and the pig field has been trimmed so as to afford better visibility to motorists.

ARG participants in some or all of the above include Tim Parker and Gyll Cowell, Rik Pond, Graham and Julie Chandler and myself.

ARG is looking forward to the time when the overgrown bushes on the land opposite Sandlings will be dealt with by Manor Tree Services now that they have finished fruiting and no doubt Jo Griffiths our local Tree Warden will be updating us all on this later in the meeting. Our thanks to Jo for renewing the plants as and when necessary.

A rota of ARG members has been established to water the planters daily and our thanks to Sharon Thick for continuing to make a ready water supply available.


