

The Just for Fun Challenge (JFF)

For most of us at the club Photography is a hobby, and although some of will inevitably spend more time and money on it than others, it should at the end of the day be fun!

The JFF Challenge is:

A monthly digital competition of 8 heats.

September to April – each competition closes on the last Sunday of the month.

Members can enter **one** photographs each month via PhotoEntry. The use of an image in this competition does not stop it being used in the EP Competition or vice versa.

The subject is “Just a bit of fun!” – that can be depicted in anyway, for example it could be:

- A humorous / creative image.
- A person having fun.
- An image that was fun to take.
- A photo with a fun caption..

The judging criteria are about how well an image depicts fun rather than strict photographic skills.

The Competition is Judged by a member selected by Pete Webster. The judge need not be the same members all the time, and Pete can choose whether or not to judge a competition himself. Being a judge does not preclude a member from entering competitions but they should not enter the one they have been asked to judge.

They will be able to view the entries on Photoentry and enter comments on the images.

The judges will select three images to go through to the final. They may use any system of choosing those two images that they wish, but no scores will be published. Just three images chosen. The judges may also Commend or Highly Commend other images.

In May, following the AGM the selected images will be shown to the members who will vote on their favourite image.

The photographer of the winning image will be awarded the JFF Challenge ~~Cup~~ Mug !

All members will be encouraged to participate, but not at the expense of the EP Competition.
