Cllr M. Lee proposed accepting the BALC accounts to 31st. March 2023. Cllr P. Lees seconded. All Agreed 2) To receive the Bank reconciliation as at 30th. April 2023

Councillors noted the Bank reconciliation as at 30th. April 2023

3) To pay Kevin B. Money Clerk salary for April and May '23 = £168.78p

4) To set the 2023/2024 subscription fees

- b) Local Highways Panel
- At the meeting Garry was shell-shocked as the meeting not enlightening
- Budget was discussed same money as last year
- £63,418 has been held back due to County not releasing money to panels
- Very confusing on schemes proposed, in the pipeline and under review
- Applications are taking too long in getting the works completed
- Not enough money to allocate

d) EALC Executive

1 meeting held regarding the insurance for BALC plus a zoom meeting

There is a change coming at EALC but no further information is available yet.

£28,000 was agreed to be spent on a zoom system at the offices. The process was not followed with complete transparency.

The insurance assistance for BALC was discussed and is still being reviewed

Any HR services from EALC need to be paid by Councils. Vine HR services have been replaced as HR to EALC. Worknest has been hired for HR services

8. Information Sharing – an opportunity for Councils to ask questions and share their experiences John Warner asked to be informed about BALC organisation. Cllr Martin Lee explained to him the workings of BALC

BDC Election process from start to finish was poorly handled.

There was no help for TC's or PC's. BDC supplied information late or not at all. Clerks were left to themselves to find out important information. The count was a farce. No organising from the top down to counters No problem with the new ID's having to be produced

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Councillor form Silver End has been given the job of Liaison officer for local surgery. He is asking for contact details of other local Parish Councils. Was told to ask the BALC Clerk for any information he may require.

How much money has been spent on the Government Levelling up agenda? There are 5 deprived areas in Essex. However, no money has been granted yet.

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Parish Assembly in Silver End - Assemblies are getting less residents attending.

The assemblies can be done via zoom, in person, refreshments, guest speaker and presentations. Cllr P. Lees from Feering PC said they had over 350 attendees at their assembly via zoom, live feed and in person.

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Have any PC's had complaints about BDC grass cutting programme. Cllr M. Lee said to contact BDC and complain about the length of the grass and make it a Health & Safety issue

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Formal meeting quarterly with BDC at Chief Executive level at BDC offices was proposed. The clerk to explore this meeting
