Bowers Gifford & North Benfleet community are being consulted on proposals in the Neighbourhood Plan documents to find out if they are acceptable to residents. The Parish Council, as the qualified body, was given the responsibility by Basildon Council, in their emerging Local Plan, to find locations for 1350 new homes and that is what it has set out to do.

The Parish Council and BGNB Steering Group has been working diligently, with the help of our consultant, Neil Homer, to look at the options available and has produced the Neighbourhood Plan for you to make comment in order to shape the more formal Regulation 14 Consultation that will take place in 2021.

The proposals identify that the housing target set by Basildon Council can be met and a new primary school can be provided together with a Community Centre, a GP surgery, a childcare nursery, shops and services to support the "One Village" vision if it can be agreed that the work done meets with your agreement. A new 'Green Ring' of footpaths and cycleways, as well as new public open spaces and woodlands, can be created around the village to prevent the village from merging with neighbouring settlements which was a view expressed in our consultation back in 2017.
