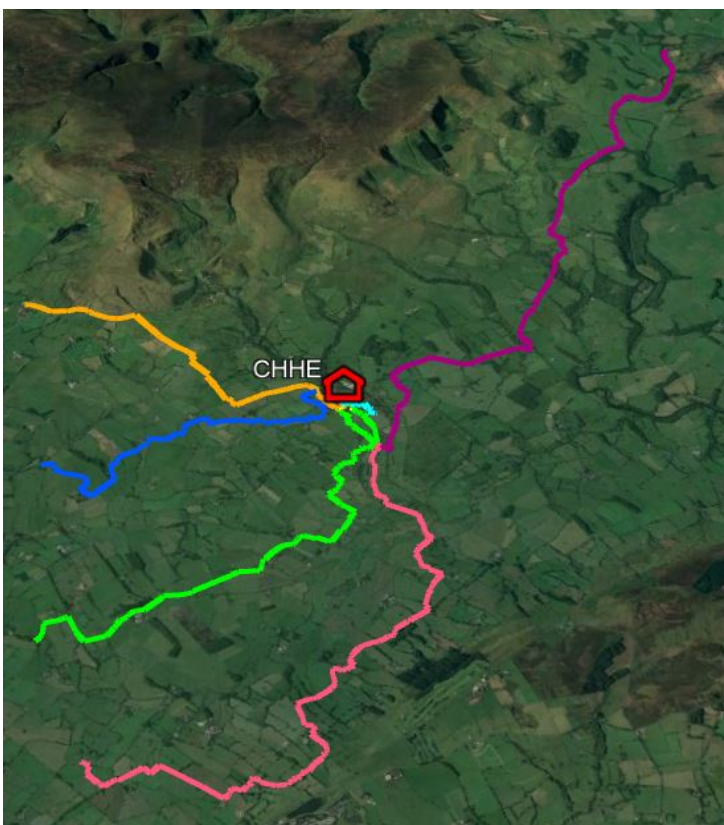




Route One - it's here!

What's next for Bowland with Leagram? We are Route 5 which is the dark pink route that will run from the Village towards Whitewell and Dunsop Bridge it will spur out to reach everyone. The fibre is taken to each property, so no telephone cables are required. See the FAQs overleaf.

B4RN FAQs

Are you frustrated with slow Broadband speeds?	B4RN will provide 1,000 Mbps – Fibre to the house
Is there a connection fee?	There is a one-off £150 connection charge. This charge covers the cost of the installation in the property and includes the cost of a router, which will be provided at the point when internet service provision is taken.
What is the monthly charge?	£30 per month (£25 plus VAT)
What is the contract term?	No long term contract – B4RN connection is on a monthly basis
I'm currently tied into a Contract – will I miss out?	You can have B4RN installed and start taking service immediately, or you can delay taking service until you're ready, or when your current phone/broadband contract expires.
Frustrated with reliability?	New fibre cables all the way to your house eliminate the reliability issues caused by the British weather and old copper lines
What about my landline?	The line is not required for the broadband, therefore no line fees.
How do I make phone calls?	There are a number of options: - Use your mobile - if you have an unreliable signal, lots of mobile providers are introducing wi-fi calling features - Adopt a landline only deal with a phone provider (From April 2018, BT are reducing the price of its monthly line rental only deal by 37%) - You can sign up to a third party 'Voice over Internet Protocol service'. If you contact your new provider before your current line is disconnected they can arrange for you to keep your existing landline number.
How can I get involved?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Volunteer Be a part of our supported project, offering your knowledge and/or a few spare hours - Customer Simply join as a customer and enjoy reliable, limitless, hyper-fast broadband for £30 per month - Investor Make a tax advantageous investment as B4RN shares qualify for EIS relief - reducing your tax bill for the year by 30% of the amount invested. (Invest £1,500 or more, and waive your £150 connection fee) Also B4RN is currently accepting a limited number of 5 year loans from the community, paying 4% interest.
