(Bradenham Road, West Wycombe)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2017

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of Bradenham Road, West Wycombe, which commences 70 metres either side of the Railway Bridge.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Bradenham Road, Wycombe Road, Bell Street, Horns Lane, New Road, Aylesbury Road, Longwick Road, Risborough Road, Ellesborough Road and vice versa.

The closure is required whilst Network Rail works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 19 March 2017 and will take approximately 3 weekends between 2300 and 0500 each day to complete.

The Order will come into operation on 19 March 2017 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
