Links Solar Farm

- Located between the villages of Bradwell (500m) to its north), Cressing (800m to its west) and Silver End (800m to its south) in Braintree, Essex
- Situated on approximately 48 hectares (111 acres)
- Links Solar Farm will supply clean power into the local distribution network to provide electricity to homes and businesses in and around the area.


Project steps
