PARISH PLAN

We will consult with the whole community to develop the Parish Plan.

- * Questionnaire delivered to every home in Bradwell, Pattiswick and Perry Green
- * Responses analysed, report issued
- * Action Plan agreed
- * Using responses, objected to Braintree District Council's Local Plan for housing development BDC officers recommend no building in Bradwell or Pattiswick as default
- * Deliver Parish Action Plan
- * Establish Parish Council Youth Committee
- Preparation of Neighbourhood Plan with residents taking the lead

FACILITIES

We will improve the facilities available to the residents of the Parish, e.g. playing field, Churchyard and Village Hall.

- Worked with Friends of Holy Trinity Church to clear scrubland in front of Church and to reclaim pond
- New contract for grass cutting to include hedge trimming and clearing, preservation of natural plants
- * Additional dog bins installed on footpaths

- * Continue support to Holy Trinity Church
- n * Installation of powered pump to church pond to prevent future flooding of graveyard
- * Additional trees to be planted in orchard
- Further improved facilities on Playing Field

ROADS

We will work to improve the quality of all roads within the Parish.

- * Speed survey undertaken in Pattiswick
