

## BRADWELL with PATTISWICK PARISH COUNCIL



The results of the Parish Plan questionnaire showed that a number of families with young children would like to see nursery provision within the parish thereby removing the need to travel to such facilities.

The Parish Council acknowledges the call for more local nursery places and would look favourably on an application for a grant to set up a play group or day nursery using Bradwell Village Hall. The Local Government Act 1972, s137, the Parish has the power to make grants to voluntary bodies without premises.
