Rules of the Competition

By entering the competition, entrants (or parents/guardians/carers) confirm that they have read and understood, and agree to be bound by, the competition rules:

- The competition is open to anyone aged 18 or under on 31st December 2016 who is a resident of Bradwell or Pattiswick.
- Entrants are asked to submit one or no more than three pictures that reflect what the orchard means to them.
- The work must be that of the entrant only, with no outside assistance.
- Drawings must be undertaken freehand, in any medium (e.g. water colour, crayon, charcoal, gtg.), but must not use any form of digital photography or enhancement.
- There will be four categories— under 5, 6-10, 11-14 and 15-18 years of age on 31st December 2016. One from each age group will be chosen as a winner, with one of these pictures being adopted as the orchard son.
- There will be a maximum of 3 pictures from each age category chosen as "runners-up".
- Each entry must be accompanied by a valid entry form and have the following information marked clearly on the back otherwise it cannot be considered: Name, address and telephone number.
 Such information will only be used by the Parish Council for the purposes of the competition.
 Where possible all pictures will be returned to the artists after the judging.
- Entries must be received by the Parish Clerk* no later than 4.00pm on Friday 25th November 2016.
- 9. The winning entrants will be informed of the results by 5.00pm on Friday 16th December 2016 and results will be posted on the Bradwell with Pattiswick Parish Council website: www.essexinfo.net/bradwell from Monday 19th December 2016. The entries for the competition shall be short-listed prior to the Parish Council meeting on Monday 12th December 2016 when the winners will be decided by the Parish Councillors. Their decision shall be final and binding. Members of the public are welcome to be present at this meeting, but may not enter into discussion or try in any way to influence Councillors either before or during the decision process.
- 10. The copyright in any image entered in the competition shall remain with the entrant. However, entrants give consent by entering this competition to the Parish Council to use any of the winning images for any publicity and/or promotional activities. In particular, the overall winner of the competition consents to their name and their winning work being used by the Parish Council in producing a notice for the Village Orchard.
- Winning and runner up entrants also give consent, by entering this competition, to their entry being included in a display at the Annual Parish Assembly in May 2017.
- There will be age-appropriate prizes for the competition winners. In addition, there will be specially designed certificates for the runners up.
- Formal prize-giving and planting of the new trees will take place in January 2017, subject to ground conditions. No cash alternative to any prize is available.
