### Report on the Electoral Roll:

The accounts had been independently examined by Antony Hutson. A vote of thanks was recorded for Mr Hutson's work and it was agreed that the PCC will write a letter of thanks to him. Revd Steven Poss suggested that the Church's Mission Statement should be reviewed and this was recorded as an action by the PCC. [Action PCC]
