
Top lights in the nave roof, changed to LED but too bright and dazzling, presently aimed at the walls that makes the nave look like a village hall and brighter than the chancel. They need to provide light to the congregation, they need spotlights with anti-glare honeycomb screens.

Not seen behind the pipe is the halogen flood up lights that need changing to LEDs.



The spot lights that have been fitted with LED bulbs in the chancel are too dazzling. May need fittings with grills or more spots at a more acute angel. The area around the choir is too dark.
