Gospel Matthew 2 vs 1 – 12

Narrator: After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked:

Magi: Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star in the east and have come to worship him.

Narrator: When King Herod heard this he was disturbed, and all Jerusalem with

him. When he had called together all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them where the Christ was to be born. They replied:

Chief priest: In Bethlehem in Judea.

Teacher: For this is what the prophet has written:

Prophet: But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among

the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will be the shepherd of my people Israel.

Narrator: Then Herod called the Magi secretly and found out from them the exact time the star had appeared. He sent them to Bethlehem and said:

Herod: Go and make a careful search for the child. As soon as you find him, report to me, so that I too may go and worship him.

Narrator: After they had heard the king, they went on their way, and the star they had seen in the east went ahead of them until it stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were overjoyed. On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold and of incense and of myrrh.

May my words be in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

"Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you." (Isaiah 60 v. 1)

If ever humanity needed a guiding light it is now, in this dark time we are experiencing around the world. Disease, death, isolation, loneliness and poverty seem to be all around us wherever we look. We have not been able to gather together as the Body of Christ and celebrate his birth – yet he is still here among us, born again in our hearts on Christmas day.

So, let us celebrate this mysterious story that Matthew brings us today; let ourselves go into it and experience the wonder and joy with those ancient visitors as they reach their surprise destination and bow down and worship. Who were these visitors, the first gentiles to see Jesus? The Magi were almost certainly astrologers from Persia or Babylonia where astrology was a well-developed science. So they would have been studying the stars intently for years and would have noticed any phenomena in the skies. Venus which shines so brightly at this time of year is dazzling enough, but this was something even more spectacular – a supernova perhaps, a comet, or most likely of all, a conjunction of the planets Saturn and Jupiter.

Since Jupiter was then regarded as a royal or kingly planet and Saturn believed to represent the Jews, the conclusion was obvious! A new King of the Jews was about to be born! No wonder King Herod got in such a panic when these Magi arrived at his palace enquiring where this "new King" could be found! I find it entertaining to imagine the commotion such an event would cause today (pre Covid19 of course.) The paparazzi would be out in force to photograph political leaders and the rich and famous who would make sure they were seen to be there, rather than concentrate on seeing God's Son for themselves; expensive tours would be arranged, SAGA would supply every single comfort imaginable for the rich elderly, while the poor would stand and watch in wonder like the shepherds Luke tells us about – but they got there first, by invitation! "The first shall be last and the last shall be first" the adult Jesus will tell his followers.

What gifts would be given today? The Magi's gifts were expensive and extraordinary, yet they represent the "wholeness" of Jesus Christ. Gold for kingship, incense for worship and myrrh which was rich with healing properties, as well as being used for embalming the dead. "Myrrh is mine, it's bitter perfume, breathes a life of gathering gloom" Oh no it doesn't! Jesus's life was NEVER gloomy. It was dynamic, inspiring, extraordinary, loving, healing, commanding, kingly and worshipful.

In these gifts, the Magi show us the Wholeness of Jesus Christ who is our Saviour, our King, our Healer, our Great High Priest, our Friend and our Brother.

The Magi were drawn to His brightness and so are we: we are drawn to what Paul tells the Ephesians is "the boundless riches of Christ...." (Ephs. 3 v. 8) Some translations say "infinite" others "unsearchable" riches.

For me, this means that the more we seek in Jesus Christ, the more we find: the more we find, the more we discover there is to find. The "light" of Isaiah's prophecy is not merely found in Jesus Christ, it IS Jesus Christ and its brightness illuminates our whole life and will shine through us into a sometimes dark, lonely and frightening world.

Paul's Ephesian letter makes it quite clear, the boundless riches of Christ are for EVERYONE not just a chosen few. Also, that Jesus Christ has no hands on earth but us who love and follow him – drawn to His Brightness. We have to bring that light into the world in His Name. That is our gift to Jesus.

As the American theologian Howard Thurman wrote:

When the song of the Angels is stilled,

When the star in the sky is gone,

When the Kings and the Princes are home,

When the Shepherds are back with their flock,

Then the work of Christmas begins:

To find the lost: To heal the broken:

To feed the hungry: To release the prisoner:

To rebuild the Nations: To bring peace among people:

To make music in the heart.
