# News from RAF Bradwell Bay

## Help us to be part of the community of Bradwell on Sea

Stories of training in Lysanders for the Special Operations Executive on the Dengie were not true. Lysanders were used and there were Lysander accidents, but all were routine flights.

However, there were links with RAF Bradwell Bay and the SOE. The link is a bit tenuous but true. The last commander, of RAF Bradwell Bay, Geoffrey Dalton Stephenson arrived in late June 1945, a couple of months after the war in Europe was over. During his tenure at RAF Bradwell Bay, it seems that he had formed a relationship with a widow named Anne Booth in St Mary's Church in Burnham on Crouch in the summer of 1946.

Where does the SOE connection come in. In 1941 Anne had married a naturalised British Army Officer known as James Menzies. He had been born in France in 1916.

Travelling to the UK specifically to join the Special Operations Executive he met Ann Jean Maureen Booth who was part of the FANY (First Aid and Nursing Yeomanry), this organisation was closely related to the SOE and supplied many agents and other staff supporting the SOE.

James Menzies (not his original name) carried out 2 missions into France as part of the Birch circuit. He was captured on his second mission and executed on 23rd March 1945 in Flossenburg concentration camp. James and Ann had a child called Anna; she received the Croix de Guerre from the French Ambassador in 1947.

James Menzies is remembered at the Brookwood Memorial. Jean Booth, usually called Maureen was the daughter of Sir Paul Booth, who had founded the Burnham on Crouch Foundry. The RAF Bradwell Bay holds many archives from the

TNA on James Menzies. In the future the Imperial War Museum will be visited as they hold personal papers of him.

Music, from daily singing in the Chapel to Bradwell's very own Eurovision in early June, is ever-important to the life of the Othona Community. From our earliest days in the Old Field, the sound of guitar and ballalauca mingled with the song of the shore birds. Music brings us together: whether planned through the Programme or shared in Chapel service, the spontaneous playing of the piano, gathering instruments with friends for pure fun, or simply singing in the kitchen, we are in harmony. Poetry features more rarely, but we have the opportunity to use this medium, exploring God's natural world, if you would like to share in our programme between 15th and 18th June. All are included, whether you book the whole residential stay, or for a day of two, coming in from home if you are fortunate enough to live close by.

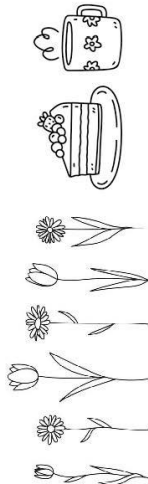
It must be sad for people who are living nearby, and who are lonely, perhaps because of a life of isolation or a recent change in circumstances, or a bereavement. Nobody living nearby need be lonely. Othona offers true community, where there are no intrusive questions about your background but a chance to talk if you want. Sometimes, sitting on the stoep or the beach may be an opportunity for quiet reflection, but there are times when a shared cuppa - and maybe even one of Ian's delicious cookies - will lead to gentle conversation, reflections on the beauty around us, and a sharing of what really concerns us, whether it be personal or global. And talking is not the only thing that keeps us together. For those inclined to action, there are always opportunities to volunteer, from cooking to shovelling, from admin to weeding. For a reminder of all the international volunteers sharing in Community in recent years, do have a look at our team on the new and improved Othona website for Essex, or for a historic view try "about" > "see and hear us" where you may relive happy memories from recent years to way back in the 1940s.

In June and July there are times when Othona is not open to all-comers, as we have a good number of school groups coming for residential or day visits, encouraging youngsters to open their eyes to the wonders of nature and to the values of sharing time together in community. At all other times, and on into August, you are all welcome to join in the Programme or just pop in; the Othona team love to greet local people and "sea wallers," who walk by on the sea wall, and pop in out of curiosity. We are drawing nearer to the time of the Big Celebration, this August, when Othona is eighty years old - we have no record of the thousands of people who have come, and will continue to come to Othona both in Essex and in West Dorset, but their memories live on. 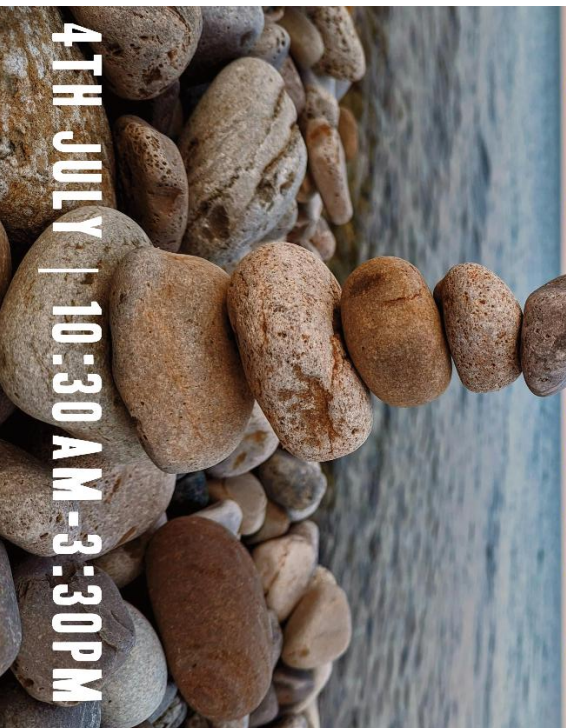

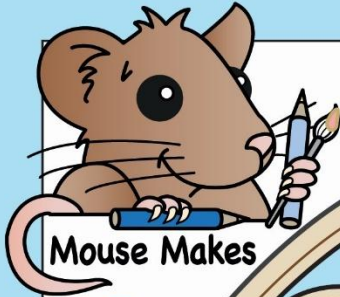
