WOODY WASTE / DEAD HEDGE: Some of you may have noticed that we've started to build a dead hedge around the seating area in front of the Community Hut. Unfortunately, we're in a long queue for the council contractor to come with a shredder, so we thought creating a dead hedge to provide a great habitat for our local wildlife might be a better use of our woody waste while we're waiting! Dead hedges provide a fabulous habitat for all sorts of creatures – we know we have hedgehogs on site, so hopefully we can provide a refuge for them too.
