

Annual General Meeting Of Buckinghamshire Branch National Association of Retired Fire Fighters.

- 1. **Welcome**: The attending members were welcomed by our President Jeff Goddard, who stated that he was sorry to have to bring out members so early on a Sunday.

- 3. **Matters Arising**: National AGM: Jeff reiterated what had occurred at the 2010 AGM to put the matter in context. The Wiltshire reps were unhappy with the direction that NARF was taking and it ended up as a row. Gerry Wilmott was very abrasive but deserved to be listened to. After the meeting Jeff Goddard went to Wiltshire and spoke to the representatives, who stated that the problem was that the Natrional Council had no direction and they could do a better job themselves. As a consequence Wiltsshire have left until improvements are made Nationally.
- 4. **Government Pensions Bill**: Jeff explained that current proposed changes means that we will all lose money, because of the change from Retail Price Index to the Consumer Prices Index would equate to a 1% difference this year, but it is a compound loss that will lose Jeff Goddard £35k over a 25 year period. NARF is not geared up for campaigning on a national scale but, we are linked to two other organisations that are namely National Pension Counbcil, (which is very union orientated)and the Public Sector Pension Council. (who are organising militant action.)

Although there is not enough money for NARF to undertake a fight over this matter we may be able to join with the FBU, but NARF should increase its income and influence in some way. Minutes are no longer being taken at National meetings, only notes for action.

There is a new editor for the magazine and the website needs to be taken in hand. A business plan is being prepared. Although the situation is not too good it is at present all we have got.
