
IVAN & WALTER CANSELL

The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations, 1950

Groups of Vehicles

A. Heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor, heavy motor car, motor car or motor tricycle equipped with means for reversing, but excluding any vehicle comprised in Group B, C, D,

NOTE.—An additional licence must be obtained before a Public Service Vehicle may be driven. No parson under 21 may drive a Heavy Goods Vehicle.

B. Agricultural tractor, but excluding any vehicle comprised in Group F.

C. Mowing machine or vehicle controlled by

D. Road roller.

E. Track-laying vehicle steered by its tracks, but excluding any vehicle comprised in Group F. F. Agricultural tractor which is a track-laying vehicle steered by its tracks.

G. Motor-bicycle (with or without side-car) or tricycle not equipped with means for reversing, but excluding any vehicle comprised in Group C. H. Trolley vehicle.

K. Vehicle exempted from duty under subsection (4) of Section 7 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act, 1949. L. Invalid carriage.
