new 400 kV substation in Bulmer. This is part of "The Great Grid Upgrade" – the largest overhaul of the grid in generations. A public consultation is now open until Monday 21 August 2023. Essex County Council, Norfolk County Council and Suffolk County Council have already raised concerns to the initial consultation undertaken last year and are calling for a coordinated offshore centred approach to energy transmission in the UK.
