EALC & ECC, National Grid, Norwich to Tilbury pylons consultation responses: Objection letters have been submitted by the Essex Association of Local Councils and Essex County Council to 183 km of new electricity transmission reinforcement between Norwich and Tilbury, made up mostly of overhead line and pylons, along with some underground cables and a new 400 kV substation in Bulmer.
