Updates:

 - **Bristol Airport Expansion** - The request from the PCAA for contributions towards Legal fees to fight the planning application was noted and, on the basis of Burrington parish population, size and the assumption that only half the estimated PCAA cost of £40,000 is to come from parish councils, all agreed that a £200 contribution to the PCAA general fund would be made.
 - **Blagdon Water Gardens** - the application for residential development has been permitted. RD will monitor road proposals that may affect the parish.
12. **Burial Ground** - a complaint regarding grass left on newly laid flowers was noted. PK advised that he has received many compliments on the high standard at which the burial ground is maintained. All agreed that a leaf blower would be purchased for use by the Village Orderly in the burial ground. HJ has identified an appropriate model at a price of £246.50 and will make the purchase on behalf of the Parish Council and provide an invoice in due course.
13. **Accounts for Payment** - payment of the accounts below proposed by HJ and seconded by RDors.
14. **Any Other Business**
 - **Parish Room** is being used by the school only, no private hire will be considered until the end of January 2021.
 - **Parish Website** - ongoing work is being undertaken by RD and can be viewed by Councillors through a website link.
 - **Auto Speed Watch** - RD is still investigating the possibilities of Auto Speed Watch - a black box which records registration numbers of speeding motorists. There are complications with acceptance by Avon & Somerset Constabulary although other police forces have taken it up.
