Last year was an amazing year for our premiership.

Trying to establish a new association in the grip of winter lockdown was never going to be easy, and we're proud of the achievements to date. We've opened a bank account & secured thousands of pounds of council grants into the local area; held monthly meetings attended by Local Ward Councillors, Neighbourhood Watch, London Assembly & others; undertaken a monthly litter pick despite the weather; organised community events (e.g. first aid training), Built a website, Purchased an AED, raised residents' concerns including fly tipping, hedge trimming and road safety with the council plus supported community initiatives such as planting and other environmental projects and generally doing what we can to help make our community a nicer place to live.

We'll continue to take forward initiatives such as the recent air pollution project, monthly litter picks, and convey important updates through our e-mail network (ButterhillRA@outlook.com) and website (butterhill.org.uk). Butter Hill Air Pollution Monitoring and Awareness

- **Description:** Butter Hill Residents Association to set up nitrogen dioxide monitoring tubes in locations of interest and engage with local people about air pollution issues
- **Justification:** The information collected through Mapping for Change will be used to help inform people about how they can reduce their own exposure and emissions by choosing healthier routes and active travel options. Hoped increased awareness will contribute to improvement in air quality.
- **Funding required:** £2,500

- **Location:** Butterhill and area between main roads
