

## March Meeting – Nicholas Corfe from GoBrazil Presenting Brazilian Wines

Another most pleasant evening was enjoyed, on the 16th March, 2023, in a relaxed atmosphere by members of the Buckingham Wine Circle. The presenter for this evenings wine tastings was Nicholas Corfe, of Go Brazil Wines.

A very informative, interesting evening with six wines to taste, three white wines and three red wines. A wine to suit everyone's pallet. Together with very comprehensive information imparted by Nicholas.

I certainly was not aware that Italians migrated to Brazil in the 1880's to cultivate a wine industry, that is beginning to become more widely known for the quality of the wine. Sales increased domestically during the period of the pandemic.

The main wine regions are located in the South East of Brazil.

- 1.Pizzato Fausto Brut Branco NV 12% Abv. £15.99 This sparkling wine 90%Chardonnay, the balance Pinot Noir.
- 2. Don Guerino Sinais Sauvignon Blanc 2022 13% Abv. £11.99 This is a very aromatic wine, with ripe tropical aromas.
- 3. Don Guerino 'Vintage' Torrontes 2021 12% Abv. £11.99 This floral wine is produced from an Argentine Grape variety.
- 4. Don Guerino Sinai's Malbec 2021 13.5% Abv. £10.99 This wine is 100% Malbec, a medium bodied wine.
- 5. Don Guerino Reserva Pinot Noir 2021 13.5% Abv£14.49 A dry medium bodied wine.
- 6. Don Guerino 'Origine 1880' Teroldego 2019 13.5% Abv. £13.99 This smooth wine is produced from a Grape indigenous to NE Italy,
