All sections will be Swiss paired over 6 rounds. This is not a knockout tournament. All players will play six games. All sections will be played to ECF Rapidplay rules using chess clocks. Each player will be allowed 30 minutes per game. Help will be given to those not used to using clocks. All sections will be graded for the ECF Rapidplay list.
