Each section will be a six round Swiss tournament in which everyone plays in all rounds. Rate of play: 30 minutes for each player to complete each game.

The ECF rules will apply and in the event of a dispute the controller's decision will be final. All games will be graded.

The sections will be: U8, U10, U12, U14, U18.

Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or split the format of any section with a low or excessively high entry.

Note: this tournament is open to anyone under 18 on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015.

All ages are as at midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015.

The U8, U10 and U12 sections are qualifying events for the London Junior Chess Championships in Harrow in December.
