It gives them the opportunity to think fully about their moves and practice the 'checks/captures/threats' move selection which coaches are always asking their students to do (but which are difficult to practice because so many Junior events are at fast time limits).

I have set up this tournament to that end. *Please don't be put off by the potentially long day – I am obliged to estimate the start/end times based on the maximum lengths of the games. In reality, I won't be surprised if the competition ends around 5pm. I can't guarantee that, but it is what previous experience tells me.*
