How many boards are played in the game?

20 Boards per county team. Any additional players can be treated as reserves and play in a reserves tournament (just like an U11 EPSCA zonal)

Who can take part?

Where is it held?

The Friendly Rapid play is held at Langley Grammar School, Langley.

What is the timetable?

The tournament lasts from 1.00 pm to 6.00 pm

There are usually 4 rounds:

Round 1	1.00 - 2.00 noon
Round 2	2.15 – 3.15 pm
Round 3	3.30 – 4.30 pm
Round 4	4.45 - 5.45 pm
