Ties; When there is a tie, normally prizes will be shared. If it is necessary to split ties, sum of opponents scores will be used. If that is equal, there will be a play-off with 5 minutes on the clocks plus 5 seconds per move from the start.

If there are not enough entries in a section, sections will be combined.

The congress is open to anyone aged under 14 on 31st August 2018. The sections will comprise Swiss Tournaments (everyone plays in all rounds) with pairings made in accordance with the basic principles of Swiss System tournaments.

ECF Membership and Grading

The results will be sent for ECF rapid play grading. The entry fee is £11.00 for junior silver members of the English Chess Federation, and £13.00 for those who are not members. Free membership until 31st August 2019 is available for junior players who have not previously been members of the ECF

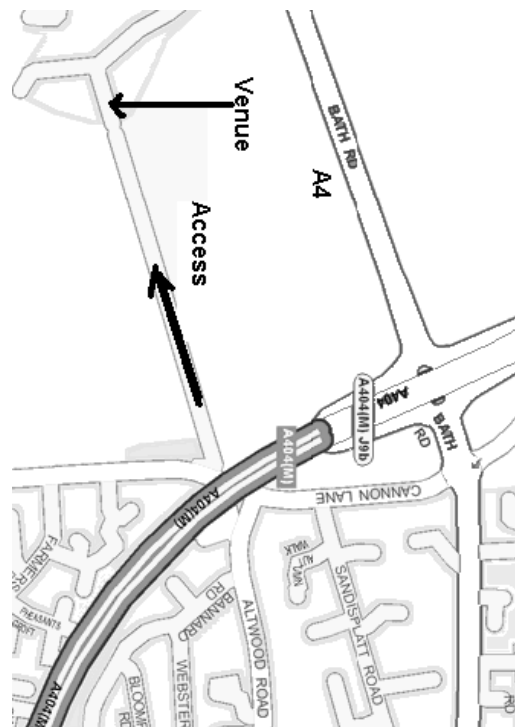
