Tournament Foreword

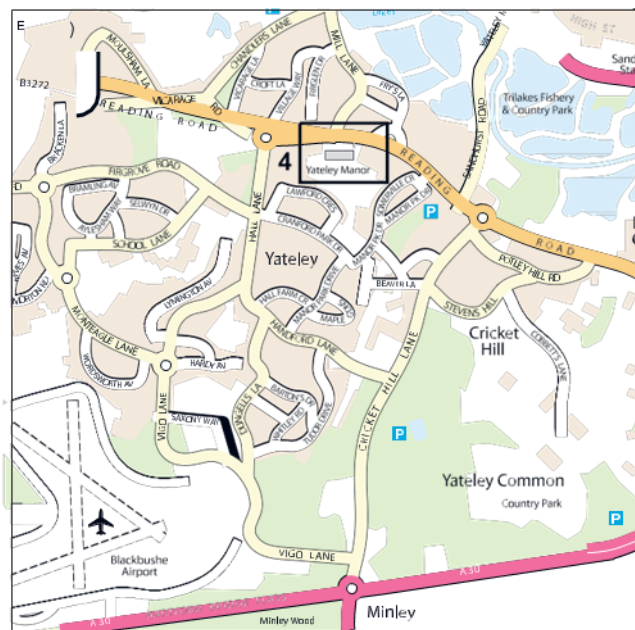
Welcome to the Congress. This is a special
