Although the research is carried out locally, the benefits of the research are far reaching and definitely not limited to Oxford. In over 30 years, Churchill Partners has raised over £1.7m.

Everyone is affected by Cancer one way or another and it is heartwarming to see the stories of the survivors thanks to the groundbreaking research which could only happen if this vital research keeps being funded by charities. We are very proud of the important contribution this small group of volunteers have made so far.

The Churchill Partners had the best year since 2019, raising just over £41,000.

£10,531 of our income came from in memoriam donations and we would like to express our gratitude to all the families who have decided to support us at this sad time, especially with the changes imposed for funerals.

Christmas card sales were again comparable to the previous year, **raising a net total of £4,894**. We could not make the cards without the excellent designs offered by our artistic supporters and the essential financial support from a small group of very generous sponsors. Most of the sponsors have supported us for a number of years and we would like to thank them for their continued interest.

Once again a core group of supporters managed to bring in some much needed income. These included the Hanney Fundraisers, Sharon Cooper, with her (Belly) Dance for Life; hanging baskets and marmalade sales; Busking sessions continued at the Roadchef services on the M11. The income from cake sales at the University Research Building at the Churchill Hospital and Race for Life flower sales continued to be very profitable. We were also delighted that new supporters in **Kingston Bagpuize and Southmoor helped our efforts, raising over £4,000.** Our ability to collect donations via contactless payment has gone from strength to strength and comprised just over 10% of our income.

On February 1st 2025, Southmoor Village Hall was filled with over 40 performers – mostly belly dancers – along with musicians and a very enthusiastic full-capacity crowd to support 'Dance for Life'. I am so grateful to everyone who gave freely of their time to make this fantastic event a reality – many of the same people who had supported me through cancer. I'm proud of myself for being brave enough to appear on stage in a bra top post-mastectomy, but even prouder that **we raised £2,090.54 for the Churchill Hospital** to continue their vital research.
