Each week, a team of volunteers reads the local newspapers and extracts the most interesting articles. The articles are edited and recorded also by volunteers. The recordings are then copied onto USB memory sticks; hundreds are packed and posted to their listeners throughout the borough.

The memory sticks can be played on an easy-to-use audio player which they can supply, or it can be played on the client's own computer or other audio device.

Keeping up to date will help clients maintain an active interest in life in and around the borough. With the arrival of familiar and trusted voices into their home each week, Talking News will provide a sense of belonging and friendship.
