- Providing support and opportunities for children and young adults with special needs and disabilities, facilities, integration, participation, and development
- Empowering disabled children and families becoming their voices
- Becoming a platform of various disabled children supporting organisations
- Promote needs and rights of disabled children, entitlements in UK
- Raising awareness about disabled children needs to relevant decision makers at all levels
- Providing services that improve the quality of lives of disabled children and their families
- Raising awareness about living with disability

The activities offered include:

- Gardening challenge (started this year following the lock down and cancellation of most of our regular activities)
- Organising Soft Play and Sensory Sessions, Group Swim, (parent and child as a team), yoga and mindfulness sessions
- Physio massage
- Creative activities for children and parents
- Educational trips abroad and within the UK that combat isolation and reduce stress
- Telephone helpline for carers and respite for families looking after children with profound needs.
