1.	<p><u>APOLOGIES AND INTRODUCTIONS</u></p> <p>The Chair opened the meeting and made introductions.</p>	
2.	<p><u>TO AGREE MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 3rd December 2012</u></p> <p>The minutes of the meeting of were agreed</p>	
3.	<p><u>MATTERS ARISING:</u></p> <p>a) PlayScheme – This is now virtually up and running apart from a few details delayed by the weather. It was hoped that at the January 28th CREPs meeting plans can be made for the launch event in the spring.</p> <p>b) One Norbiton – One Norbiton is now a company with five priority sub groups. The company is now applying for data protection in the One Norbiton name. Current priorities are focussed on NEETS (Not in Employment, Education or Training) from 16-24 and other Norbiton residents who need help back in to work or training. To this end a ‘Worklessness’ meeting was held on 7th January in the Guildhall , Chaired by Cllr Penny Shelton. It was attended by key officers from all agencies who have an input in this area in the hope that a joint approach will be more effective. PS had suggested at this meeting that it may be that residents will need to be approached directly on a ‘house-to-house’ basis in order to establish who is in need of support. The Chair reported that she had offered the services of CREst volunteers to help with this is necessary. This was agreed.</p> <p>c) Drama – JR has been in contact to report that he is hoping to start the drama course in the spring and will attend the next meeting to discuss this which days the halls are available for this after school. JP reported that an ‘extra’s booking agency’ has been in contact to ask if CREst would be prepared to facilitate a casting session for an upcoming project.
