- d) **Environmental Funding RBK** This was £75k that RBK have to improve the environment on both estates. At present One Norbiton are working on this.

e) **Gardening Group** - MG explained the history of this project. When she was Manager of CAP (Community Action Partnership) the initial resident consultations highlighted a need for a gardening project. This had been pursued and was finally brought to fruition in January 2011. It has now been reported by CRERA that the project has ceased and the land returned to RBK. However, it is hoped that the improvements introduced as part of the Play Scheme project will re-vitalise it.

Local problems - There have been a couple of problems reported with local young people. However it seems that this is as a result of the fact that there are few facilities available locally. JP has spoken with several of the young people and they also attended the CREWPs consultation .As a result it seems that there is a need for a boxing club locally. Harry Hall has written to CREst inviting us to send a delegate to a meeting he has convened to discuss re-opening the Surrey Sports Centre , including the provision of a gym and boxing club. MG agreed to attend as she has been involved in 2 previous funding attempts.
