The SOFA15 programme is a fully inclusive activity programme organised by young people for young people
BAPP have run SOFA for 8 years with over 1,500 young people having a summer of fun!

The inclusive SOFA programme is open to ALL disabled and non-disabled young people.

We will support everyone to participate in activities they choose to do. We are providing the activities with the agreement that everyone behaves in an acceptable way including the staff
Stick to the rules, or you'll be OFF the programme!

Code of Conduct for all young people & staff:

- Listen to instructions
- Ask if you don't understand or you are not clear
- Behave in a way that is acceptable to everyone
- Speak to people politely
- Respect other people and their space
- Speak up if you don't agree or have a different idea
- Wear seat belts on transport at all times

How do I book?

Look at the programme and decide which days you would like to attend. Number your activities with 1 being your first choice.

You can choose as few or as many as you would like to do.

The more you choose, the more you get.

Fill in the booking form, get a parent/carer to give consent and sign the form and send it back to us.

All information about you will be held confidentially by BAPP
Each day will cost between £8 and £15 depending on activity.

Booking forms must come with payment of £10 to secure place.

You must pay in full before the 10th July 2015

Getting there

Accessible transport is available for all activities.
Please tick on the booking form if you would like to use transport.
We will NOT be able to drop anybody off other than pick-up and drop-off points. **Seatbelts MUST be worn at all times**
Pick-up locations and times will be given with the confirmation.

What if I'm ill or can't attend?

You **MUST** let **SOFA** staff know by ringing or texting the Development Worker on **07814 780850** at least **48 hours** before the day. This gives us the chance to fill the place. You will not be refunded if you do NOT inform us/we are unable to fill the space..

I need support to participate

BAPP SOFA staff are experienced at working with disabled young people. We will do our best to support you - please tell us what we can do to support you. If you want to bring a key worker or Personal Assistant, that is fine. We do need to know this for transport.

You will receive a confirmation email or letter confirming which days you have been allocated. Do NOT assume that you will get everything you want!

Further information will be given once you have booked. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU BRING WHAT YOU NEED

SOFA15 Wristbands will be provided on the first day you attend. These must be worn during the programme so you can get on transport and take part in activities.
