
# Integrated Working Newsletter

### Launch of a new e-learning module

#### **Family Feedback**

Following a mail out to children, young people and families who undertook a common assessment last year, we received 46 responses which exceeded last year's response rate. 6 came directly from young people. Families and young people commented positively on early intervention and on specific services. "Enabled all involved to pass information to each individual."

There is still some work to do to ensure that families are fully engaged in the assessment process. However, overall the responses were more positive than in previous years, and the increased willingness of professionals to act as Lead Professional is valued by families.
