Due to the nature of security work, there are a few requirements for young people to meet before they join the course. • In order to gain the SIA licence, young people must have photo ID and documents to prove their current address. Please check with young people you are referring that they either have 2 documents from group A or 1 document from group A and 2 from Group B using this list on the SIA website: http://www.sia.homeoffice.gov.uk/Pages/licensing-document-groups.aspx • Unfortunately, it is unlikely that a young person with an unspent conviction or recent caution will be able to obtain the SIA licence. Any unspent convictions or cautions relating to theft, drug offences, sexual offences or violence will certainly not be considered. If in doubt please check the list on the SIA website: http://www.sia.homeoffice.gov.uk/Pages/licensing-cri.aspx or use the useful quiz on the website to check if your offences will be allowed.	The SIA badge will be fully funded by Princes Trust as long as the young person secures a job in 3 months after completing the programme. 85% of young people on the last security programme are now in employment within security.

	 Young people will need to have lived in the UK for the last 5 years so that SIA can complete a full DBS check. They will also need to be able to trace their employment history for these 5 years – this might include periods of signing on at the job centre (which they can prove using a letter from the job centre). If successful at joining the programme, young people will also need passport photos for SIA exam registration purposes. Young person must be at a Level 1 in English (able to read and write well) due to the SIA assessments.
