Children & Young people's Sub Group of the Health & Well Being Board

- This was the first meeting of the group which will feed into the Health & Well Being Board. Terms of reference are still to be finalised in terms of reporting/feeding up to the HWB and the need to keep information succinct and clarity about who will make decisions
- We discussed the strategies/plans relevant to children and young people and how these will be aligned to the HWB themes and Priorities. The Voluntary Sector is asked whether there are any that are missing and to add them to the grid attached and send back to Sue.
- We discussed use of the Outcomes Based Accountability form of reporting and the development pf a template as the sub group will need to produce a 6 monthly report to the HWB Board, the first due in early December 2016. This will help the HWB Board to understand the difference the services are having for children and young people and the need to reflect the scope of services whether commissioned or not.
- There was agreement that the CYP Plan data does not necessarily reflect the range of services that children and young people are using as many services are not commissioned however they are all contributing to improved outcomes for children and young people in B&NES. Unanimous agreement that the CYP Network be asked to contact groups, those who are not commissioned by B&NES, for data on the numbers of children/young people being supported, frequency of support and the difference the services are making/ how they are contributing to plans.
