1	It was agreed that Early Help will become a sub group of the LSCB to comply with Ofsted and Working Together, LSCB will have a strategic overview of the outcomes of Early Help.
2	<p>Sharing information re Serious case reviews, family E. See learning in the attached sheet.</p> <p>Dorset serious case review – involves a non-mobile child and practitioners not being aware of the bruising protocol. 3	<p>Listening to the voice of the child.</p> <p>Importance of listening to children's voices as a regular activity so that plans involving children can accurately reflect their voice their wishes and feelings and as a result improve outcomes.</p> <p>What currently goes on and what can we do better?</p>
4	Wood review – future of LSCB. Looking to increase in joint working. Increase communications, increase in sub groups, increase in links with other boards. Still much uncertainty on what LSCB will look like.

6	<p>Bath and North East Somerset CAMHS Stakeholder Feedback - December 2016</p> <p>Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust (the CAMHS provider) successfully gathers service user feedback and regularly reports this to commissioners. Despite concerted efforts, there has been little success in gathering representative feedback from other stakeholders.</p> <p>At a previous LSCB meeting (1st December 2015), the LSCB agreed to collaborate on gaining CAMHS stakeholder feedback.</p> <p>A very simple questionnaire, that should require no longer than 5 minutes to complete, has been incorporated into an online survey available here: https://www.surveymonkey.co.uk/r/PQDFFXQ please could agencies complete this by the first week in January.</p>
5	<p>CSE in sporting groups. Discussions about the media reports of sexual abuse in football. General understanding that the abuse reported so far has been historic.</p> <p>Message to voluntary sector groups to check their procedures.</p>
6.	<p>New joint LSCB and LSAB web site due to go live in the new year. Standalone web site, not within B&NES web site. Link to be disseminated when the web site goes live.</p>
